## READING LOG

- ✓ Reward your child's reading efforts with a bonus sticker at the end of the week as well.

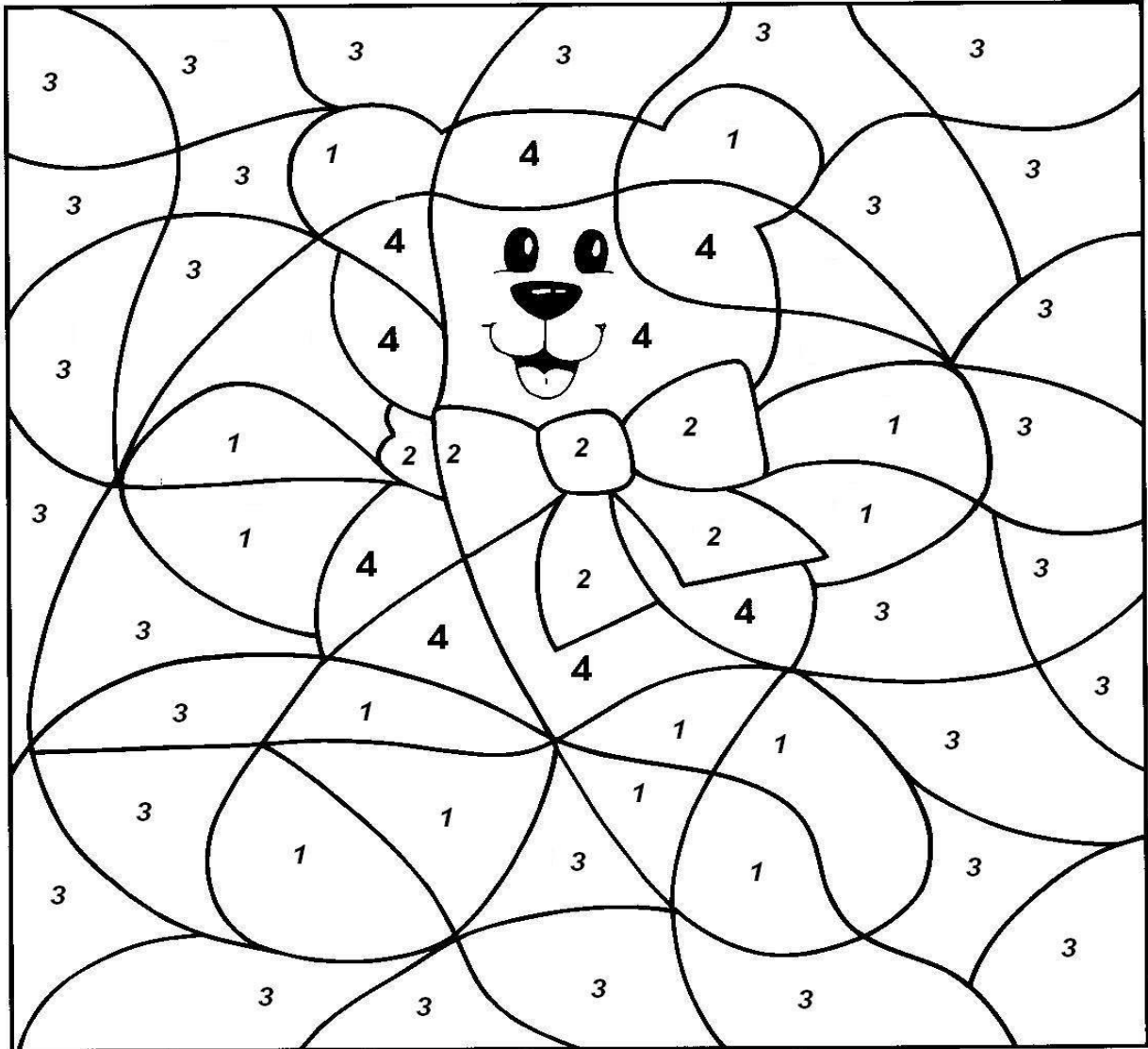
